

**Free Wireless POS (Point of Sale) Equipment from Indiana FSSA
For Farmers Markets & Direct Market Farmer's**

The only requirement for the free wireless equipment is to be a SNAP authorized retailer, approved by FNS as a qualified farmer's market or direct market farmer. Indiana FSSA EBT Processor, Conduent, provides the equipment through CDE/goEBT.

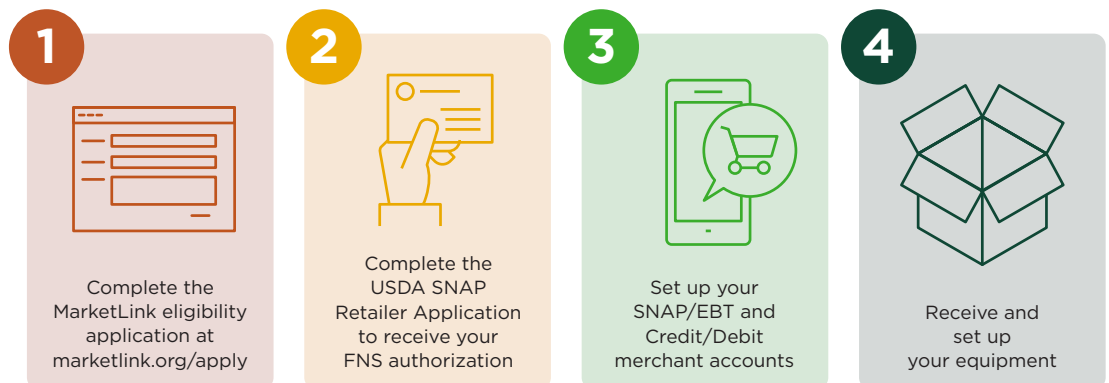
