Have a SNAP/EBT Card? Get FREE Fruits & Veggies

What is Double Up?

- Double Up is a program that gives you free fruits and vegetables when you use SNAP/EBT.
- Each purchase using a SNAP/EBT card earns a \$1 for \$1 match (or 50% off) when you buy fruits and veggies!

How Do I Use Double Up?

- First, visit a market or store that offers Double Up: see below or visit DoubleUpIndiana.org
- Make sure you use your SNAP/EBT card to make purchases.
- Follow the instructions from farmers market or store staff – each offers the free produce in a slightly different way.

Where Can I Use Double Up?

- Fort Wayne's Farmers Market, 1795 Broadway, Wednesdays 3-7 p.m. and Saturdays 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. May-September. Indoor market at Parkview Field, 285 Douglas Ave. Saturdays 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., October-April.
- Johnnie Mae Farm, 2518 Winter St., Fridays, May-September, 2-6 p.m. Customers get 50% off cost of produce when purchasing with SNAP/EBT.
- McCormick HEAL Market, 3005 McCormick Ave., Wednesdays, July-September 8, 5-7 p.m. Customers receive \$1 for every \$1 they spend in SNAP/EBT.
- Parkview Greenhouse HEAL Market, 1716 Beacon St., Thursdays, July-September 9, 4-6 p.m. Customers receive \$1 for every \$1 they spend in SNAP/EBT.
- Plowshares Booth at YLNI Farmers Market, Barr Street between Wayne and Berry, Saturdays, May-September, 9 a.m.-1 p.m. Customers get 50% off cost of produce when purchasing with SNAP/EBT.
- South Side HEAL Farmers Market, 3300 Warsaw St., Saturdays, July-September, 8 a.m.-Noon. Customers receive \$1 for every \$1 they spend in SNAP/EBT.
- 3 Rivers Food Co-Op, 1612 Sherman Blvd., Mondays-Saturdays 9 a.m.-7 p.m., Sundays Noon-6 p.m. Customers get 50% off cost of produce when purchasing with SNAP/EBT.

What Products Can I Buy with Double Up Food Bucks?

- You can purchase fresh fruits and vegetables, mushrooms, and fresh herbs.

Is There a Limit to the Amount of Double Up Food Bucks I Can Use?

- You can use up to \$20 per day, per customer.
